1756 Landed in Dover
1764-1773 Published "The Traveller", "The
Deserted Village", "The Vicar of
Wakefield", "The Good Natured Man",
"She Stoops to Conquer"
1774 Died April 4* and buried in the Temple
1775 Travelled on foot in France, Germany
Switzerland and Italy.
